


REMOVAL

- 1. REMOVE WIPER ARMS
- 2. REMOVE HOOD TO COWL TOP SEAL
- 3. REMOVE COWL TOP VENTILATOR LOUVERS




4. REMOVE SUN VISOR

- (a) Using a moulding remover, remove the visor arm case.
- (b) Remove the 2 screws and sun visor.
- (c) Employ the same manner described above to the other side.




5. REMOVE VISOR HOLDER

- (a) Remove the screw.
- (b) Using a moulding remover, remove the visor holder.
- (c) Employ the same manner described above to the other side.



6. REMOVE CENTER VISOR ASSEMBLY


Using a moulding remover, remove the center visor assembly as shown in the illustration.



7. REMOVE INNER REAR VIEW MIRROR

Remove the 2 screws and inner rear view mirror, then disconnect the connector.


8. REMOVE MAP LIGHT ASSEMBLY

(a) Using a screwdriver, remove the map light lens.

HINT:


Tape the screwdriver tip before use.

(b) Remove the 2 screws and map light assembly, then disconnect the connector.



REMOVE FRONT PILLAR GARNISH

- (a) Disengage the clip at the lead edge of roof side inner rail.
- (b) Disengage the clips, remove the front pillar garnish by pulling up.
- (c) Employ the same manner described above to the other side.




10. REMOVE WINDSHIELD OUTSIDE NO.2 MOULDING

(a) Using a screwdriver, remove the windshield outside No.2 moulding.

HINT:


Tape the screwdriver tip before use.

(b) Employ the same manner described above to the other side.



11. REMOVE WINDSHIELD OUTSIDE MOULDING

- (a) Remove the 5 screws.
- (b) Slowly remove the moulding while separating the adhesive tapes.
- (c) Employ the same manner described above to the other side.



12. REMOVE WINDSHIELD OUTSIDE UPPER MOULDING

Manually peel off the edge to remove the moulding.

13. REMOVE WINDSHIELD GLASS


HINT:

When the glass is reused, apply adhesive tape or a like to the glass and body, and draw matching marks using a pen.

- (a) Disconnect the connector.
- (b) Apply the protective tape onto the body around the outside circumference of windshield glass.



(c) Push piano wire through between the body and glass from the interior.




(d) Tie both wire ends to wooden blocks or similar objects. HINT:

Apply protective tape to the outer surface to keep the surface from being scratched.



NOTICE:

When separating the glass, take care not to damage the paint and interior and exterior ornaments. To prevent scratching the safety pad when removing the windshield, place a plastic sheet between the piano wire and safety pad.



- (e) Cut the adhesive by pulling the piano wire around it as shown in the illustration.
- (f) Remove the windshield glass.

NOTICE:

Leave as much of the adhesive on the body as possible when cutting off the glass.
